## **Discussion:**

- Mrs. Leticia Cadena welcomed the members to the meeting and asked for a moment of silence to honor Mrs. Velma Arevalo.
- Mrs. Yadira E. Diaz shared 3<sup>rd</sup> Six Weeks Campus Benchmark results and reminded teachers to continue to work hard in order for every student to achieve success. Index and Safeguards results from the Accountability System were also shared.
- Mrs. Marylou Cruz, Federal Programs Director, presented 3<sup>rd</sup> Six Weeks Benchmark results for Migrant and LEP students. For the Bilingual/ESL program, most campuses and grade levels are reaching the participation rate but falling behind in the passing rate. Mrs. Cruz thanked the teachers for their hard work and encouraged them to continue to actively engage all of our students. She also emphasized the importance of monitoring the M1 and M2 students. TEA will be monitoring data on M3, M4 and M5 students and releasing this data sometime this year. Overall the migrant students are performing well; however, a focus on Reading was recommended at all levels due to not meeting the target score.
- Mr. Joe Martinez reminded the committee that February is Career and Technical Education month. Middle Schools and High School CATE teachers will be honored and recognized at this month's board meeting. There will be a full-page ad in the local newspaper bringing awareness to the community regarding the program. There will also be information on GTN, Facebook and the district website. He also shared information regarding TEPLAS testing. The window begins February 26 and ends April 6.
- Mrs. Leticia Cadena reviewed the Comprehensive Needs Assessment reminded committee members that they will be receiving information regarding committee meetings to review and edit the 2018-2019 District Improvement Plan.
