What is a CTE Advisory Committee?

A CTE Advisory Committee is a representative group of individuals whose experience and abilities represent a cross section of a particular occupational area. The primary purpose of the CTE advisory committee is to assist educators in establishing, operating, and evaluating programs which serve the needs of students, business and industry, and to provide expertise pertaining to technology change.

Why are CTE Advisory Committees Needed?

Committees are needed:

- To provide an opportunity for discussion among people in education, business, and industry.
- To focus on how to improve Career and Technical Education (CTE) and make the most of the community resources available.
- To strive to improve the relationships between CTE, business, and industry.
- To provide expertise to the program by reviewing curriculum, facilities, budget, student competencies, and student placement in related occupations.

Requirements:

- Local schools and institutions that operate CTE programs receive state and federal funds, and are required by the Career and Technical Act to establish and operate Program Advisory Committees.
